Two-Year Post Graduate Programme in Management (PGP) 2012-14 Batch Admissions
WAT and PI Shortlisting Procedure

IIM Indore follows a two-stage selection process for admission to PGP 2012-14 Batch Admissions.

Stage 1: Shortlisting for WAT and PI

Initial Screening:

Candidates satisfying the minimum criteria mentioned in table 1 are considered for further sectional process. Number of candidates satisfying the CAT 2011 criteria in each category is given in table 1. These candidates were considered for further shortlisting.

Preparation of merit list:

Candidates satisfying the minimum criteria (given in table 1) were considered for further shortlisting process. For each candidate a composite score is computed using the relation given below.

Composite Score (100%) = Std Score (CAT 2011 Section 1 (20%) + Section 2 (30%) + Academic (SSC (15%) + HSC (15%) + BD (15%)) + Professional Diversity (5%)).

Candidates' aggregate marks in SSC, HSC and Bachelor Degree have been normalised using database of CAT 2009, 2010 and 2011. Normalised scores were computed using the following relation:

Normalised Score of a candidate X in SSC = (Aggregate percent marks of candidate X in SSC of board B – Cluster Average percentage of marks of SSC board)/ Cluster Standard deviation of SSC board.

Same procedure is used for finding normalised scores for each candidate in HSC and Bachelor Degree. These normalised scores have been used in computing the standard scores (Std Score) mentioned in the composite score. Component wise description of standard scores and weightages are given in table 2.

*For candidates, across all categories (General, NC-OBC, SC, ST and PWD), with professional diversity (like CA, ICWA, CS, Medicine, Dentistry and Law) a maximum of 5 points is awarded as per the formula given in table 2.

A merit list based on composite score is prepared and required number of candidates from each category is arrived. As decided by the Admissions Committee of IIM Indore, under each category seven times of intake has been shortlisted for WAT and PI. Number of candidates shortlisted is given in table 3 along with proposed intake as per Government of India reservation norms.

In addition to the above 27 candidates with GMAT scores under general category were also shortlisted for WAT and PI.

Stage 2: Final Selection: A merit list of candidates based on overall performance in CAT, WAT and PI will be prepared using the following final composite score and final admission offers will be made as per government of India reservation norms.

$$\text{Final Composite Score (FCS)} = \text{CAT 2011 (50\%)} + \text{WAT (15\%)} + \text{PI (35\%)}$$
