#### **Entrepreneurs of Planet-I**

#### How did your entrepreneurial journey start?

I think the journey of an entrepreneur (or any other talent) starts at two levels. The first level is when one starts dabbling in the space unknowingly, tastes small successes, and keeps doing it. All this while, the experience remains fuzzy and enjoyable, but nothing more. The second level is when one formally jumps into the field. My first level started when I must be in early school and continued at IIM Indore. I set up a library of my books and those of my friends, created many small properties like cricket tournaments, Indian festivals related events, and sold many tours and merchandise. My first formal stint came in when a friend asked for help with his retail idea. I was employed with Adidas then. I helped him with the business plan and initial setup while I continued to do my job. Finally, when the business took some shape and needed my full-time commitment, I took the plunge.

#### Briefly describe your business and why you chose this particular field?

The brand name of my current business is TailorWear. As the name suggests, we offer tailored apparel to men. Unlike traditional tailors, we do it in multiple cities and countries. We are on a mission to be the personal tailor stylists of our customers wherever they are in the world. Having worked in the apparel space, I feel that the best apparel for anyone is a tailored one. The problem is that good tailors are not available ("a dying tribe"). Those around are either too expensive, too boring, or very bad. We are working on changing this by bringing a scientific approach, maintaining high customer standards, and using technology extensively. We feel that TailorWear has the potential to become a threat to all the ready-to-wear, formal brands in India and abroad because of its unique offering.

#### What were the major challenges you faced in starting your business?

Lifestyle business depends on discretionary expenses and therefore relies heavily on consumer sentiments.

As soon as we had started our venture, government measures like demonetization and GST disrupted many businesses, especially the textile industry, because it was out of tax purview earlier. Then came Covid, which slaughtered many sectors, including ours.

Having said this, I must say that I think the rapidly changing world has created a level playing field that offers more promise to the new entrants.

I am more hopeful today than when we had started.

# Did you go for external funding for your start-up/ firm? What factors helped you to secure such funding?

No, we have not raised any external funding as yet.

Consumer businesses, especially the branded ones, start seeing an exponential rise in their value after they hit a certain point in their life cycle.

There are various reasons behind it which is a subject of another discussion. I believe if one can sustain till that point, the outcome is much sweeter and more empowering for the company. We plan to bootstrap till then and focus on continuous improvement and ensuring continuity in our offering.

#### What would be your advice for an MBA who is considering a startup?

B-school is a fantastic place to test and incubate ideas. A two-year window amid a fabulous infrastructure, industry and academic environment, and like-minded batchmates offer immense possibilities. I believe that day is not far when new business launches will become equally important events, if not bigger, than the placements. Given my thoughts, I advise the budding entrepreneurs at B-schools to not waste any time and utilize all the resources that I mentioned above to launch their business before leaving the campus.

If you are still not sure about starting up at this stage, you can look at joining one as an employee to gain first-hand experience. Nowadays, many companies look at candidates with start-up experience in their profile very favorably. So even if you decide against starting a business, your employment profile won't see a setback.
