## 1. How did your entrepreneurial journey start?

Being a doctor by first training, during my clinical practice with Fortis Hospitals in their Cardiology department, I realised the big opportunity presented by the nascent Corporate Healthcare in India. That's why I decided to do an MBA to augment my managerial skills.

Post my MBA from IIM Indore, I have had a successful 13+ year stint as a private Equity investor - investing into healthcare companies – 4 of which went on to become India's largest in their respective sub sectors.

This made me understand the various gaps in the healthcare ecosystem in which was sub optimally served and ripe for disruption. Hence, in early 2020 we took a plunge to solve the Secondary care planned surgeries market in India.

## 2. Briefly describe your business and why you chose this particular field?

Glamyo Health (www.glamyohealth.in) is an asset light healthcare service provider with a razor sharp focus on solving the real pain points that the patients unfortunately have to experience when they undergo surgery.

We have helped more than 300k patients with free medical counselling sessions, helping more than 1500 patients ease out their surgical journey every month.

We have been able to provide cutting edge treatments like laser and laparoscopic minimally invasive treatments - reducing the post operative recovery time and allowing the patient to resume his normal life significantly quicker.

Glamyo Health is well on its way to touch 1 million lives in the next 12 months as we scale to 45+ cities of the country.

Reasons to choose this field – Strong Unit economics, blue ocean market (secondary care surgeries is a 30 bn + market), real pain point for patients, prior experience in scaling up start-ups as a healthcare investor.

# 3. What were the major challenges you faced in starting your business?

We started the business in Feb 2020 after we raised our small seed round. Lo and behold, within 30 days, the PM announced nationwide lockdown and there was an uncertainty right at the beginning whether we will be **Covid babies OR Covid Orphans**.

In hindsight ( and hindsight is 20/20 vision), this was the best thing that could have happened to us. We were forced to be lean and innovate on almost all aspects of the business. I would say that has a huge contribution in whatever little we have been able to scale.

# 4. Did you go for external funding for your start-up/ firm? What factors helped you to secure such funding?

Yes we have raised external funding for Glamyo Health. We have raised Series A funding of 6 Mn USD and currently raising a series B round of 15 Mn USD.

## 5. What would be your advice for an MBA who is considering a startup?

Right now is possibly the best time to explore entrepreneurship option. Even if you are not ready to start on your own, you would do well to experience the chaos at a bustling start up. And if you are wanting to start something on your own, focus on following things.

- Identify the idea with following characteristics
  - Large addressable market, you ideally, should not be later than 3rd player in the market
  - Niche market Preferably first offering in that market

• Be brutally honest with yourself when evaluating the idea. If you fail, you don't only loose time but the guts to do a start -up again

• Solve a real pain point or need.

• No one can steal your idea. Execution is the biggest moat / differentiation unless you are making a rocket ala Elon Musk.

- You don't have to be the highest paid person in the company.
  - Digital marketing Hire the best possible resource that you can find. He/ she will come at a salary - multiples of yours – Be ok with it.

• Focus on Sales, Sales in the first 6-12 months even if the product / offering is only 60% of what it should be. An MVP doesn't always need a code or an app

• If you have a dashboard of more than 5 metrics, you haven't still understood the business fully

• You are never fully ready.

• Co-founder – Best to have up to 3 people as co-founders. Less means lots of work load and more than 3 leads to too much democracy. Ideally it helps if one of them is a tech geek -if you are not

• Funding doesn't guarantee success. Most often when people have money, they start throwing people at problems rather than solving actual pain point. Don't be loose with money even when you have it.
