## TITLE OF THE COURSE: Business Ethics: Learning the Integrative Live Case (ILC) Way (Workshop) CREDITS: 2

## **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

This ten session workshop course deploys a traditional method of imparting Business Ethics Education. Based on the IBS (individual, business and society) framework it offers a course plan spread over ten sessions. The course would include some of the most prominent and scholarly insights in the domain of business ethics. More importantly, the course seeks to conduct the classes with the active involvement of the participants, and hence aims for participant centred learning.

## **COURSE OBJECTIVES:**

The workshop has the following objectives:

- Ethics as a concept has grey areas and therefore it is important for participants to get introduced to varied points of view as regards origin of ethical issues and the wide-ranging implications they have on different stakeholders. In short, the course seeks to focus on participant centred learning for appreciation of ethical issues from multiple perspectives
- Through critical examination of the various ethical concepts the course seeks to inspire participants to engage in a thorough examination of individual thinking across levels, functions and roles
- Examine the various inter-linkages in the evolution of an organization's ethical climate
- Appreciate the inter-dependence between societal actions and ethical incidents
