## INTEGRATED PROGRAMME IN MANAGEMENT (IPM) TERM: IX

TITLE OF THE COURSE: Competition Policy: Theory and Practice

**CREDITS: 3** 

## **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This is an advanced undergraduate level course to introduce students with the theory of anticompetitive practices of the firms and the role of competition policy by the government to regulate such practices. The students are expected to have basic knowledge of the microeconomic concepts for the course. A good understanding of basic calculus would be an added advantage.

## **COURSE OBJECTIVES**

The primary objective of the course is to enable students to 1) to introduce the students with the basic concepts of anti-competitive practices of the firms in a market economy, 2) provide a theoretical understanding and implications of anti-competitive practices, 3) familiarize with the landmark cases in the context of competition policy from USA, European Union and India.
