COURSE DESCRIPTION

Emphasis will be laid on introducing features associated with development and underdevelopment, various theories of economic growth, and distributional as well as institutional aspects of economic development.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

At the end of the course, students are expected to understand the features of development; understand and interpret various development indicators; understand the micro-economic foundations of underdevelopment and the policy measures that could facilitate economic development; and familiarize themselves with various data sources and applications related to economic growth and development.
