Programme overview: Programme overview: There is a sharp increase in the number of business schools in the last two decades due to the popularity and increase in the demand of MBA graduates. On the other hand, most of these business schools are facing a shortage of recruiting good quality faculty in the institutes. The problem of good quality faculty is more severe among the lower ranked business schools. These institutes/faculty generally lack in planning and sourcing the requisite resources on required teaching and research skill development programs. This gap can be filled by top business school in the country such as the IIMs. This is possible by exposing the pedagogical tools, techniques and concepts being used in teaching and research by IIM faculty to other faculty. Improving the teaching and research skills of faculty in operations and supply chain management (OSCM) are the major outcomes of this FDP.

- To introduce best practices and important concepts in teaching Operations and Supply Chain Management (OSCM) topics in MBA curriculum
- To demonstrate the use of alternative pedagogical tools such as cases, games and software in teaching OSCM courses
- To improve the research aptitude among the participants by introducing popular research theme /methodologies in OSCM

Content: The content of the program basically will encompass the following structure for delivery.

1. Teaching Operations and Supply Chain Management (OSCM) course
 - Preparing the course outline
 - Operations management (Process analysis, inventory, quality etc)
 - Quantitative Management (Linear programming, statistics etc)
 - Supply Chain Management (coordination, network etc)
2. Usage of the pedagogical methods in OSCM courses by using
 - Business games
 - Conceptual Cases (if possible open source cases)
 - Software tools for modeling & analysis (including excel)
3. Improve the research aptitude
 - Conducting literature review
 - Use of research methodologies for OSCM research (case study, optimization)

Target audience: Faculty / Instructors from business schools and industry working in operations and supply chain management area

Delivery Mode: The classes will be scheduled on an online platform. IIM Indore will provide requisite access to the online platform via a login account. Participants are required to have access to a personal computer/laptop and stable internet connection to access the classes.
