INTEGRATED PROGRAMME IN MANAGEMENT (IPM)

TERM: III

TITLE OF THE COURSE: DANCE – III

CREDITS: 4

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is to give introduction to the IPM students about Dance as a performing Art. Students will be exposed to various dance styles during their learning. Elements of Folk, Classical and western - contemporary dance styles will be taught to them. By the end of the course students *need* to choreograph a dance production using the learnt dance styles and perform it for the assessment.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Dance course III, focuses on the development and performance of the learner's own choreography and performance in group. Candidates receive training on techniques of different dance styles. In this term they will be exposed to the dance drama concepts. They will be depicting words through gestures, expressions and body movements. They will be shown examples of famous maestros and exponents of dance dramas. They begin to develop critical skills for the analysis of choreography and performance within their own work and in professional repertoire.
