COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course intends to deal with certain relevant themes which have shaped the contours of world politics in contemporary times. These themes can neither be solely studied under the broad brush of what we consider as 'historical' nor can they be studied in isolation as 'political'. Therefore, this course tries to introduce the participants to certain themes which have been influenced by mutual reinforcement of certain historical and political factors. These historical and political factors have gone a long way in influencing the contemporary world. Though titled 'World History and Politics' this course is not about unraveling of historical events and significant political developments in post medieval times. This course is designed with the intention that exposure to such a course will go a long way in appreciating and developing an informed understanding and awareness of global issues by contextualizing them in the appropriate historical and political context

- To introduce students to the most significant historical and political developments in the post-medieval times
- To understand and appreciate how significant historical and political developments had mutually affected each other and led to unfolding of certain forces which have shaped the contemporary world.
