

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

The Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) at the end of a year is the weighted average of the grade points obtained in all courses registered by the participant. Non-credit courses are not included in calculating CGPA. The weights used are the course credits. The PGP Executive Committee No. 14 in its meeting held on 26 September 2018, approved the calculation of an indicative percentage equivalence of CGPA can be calculated as follows:

If, $3.5 \leq \text{CGPA} \leq 4.33$	=	$91 + (\text{CGPA} - 3.5) \times 10.8434$
If, $2.3 \leq \text{CGPA} < 3.5$	=	$60 + (\text{CGPA} - 2.3) \times 25.8334$
If, $2 \leq \text{CGPA} < 2.3$	=	$50 + (\text{CGPA} - 2) \times 33.3334$
If, $1 \leq \text{CGPA} < 2$	=	$20 + (\text{CGPA} - 1) \times 30$

For example, if the CGPA is 2.33, the percentage equivalence would be $60 + (\text{CGPA} - 2.33) \times 25.8334 = 60.77\%$
